Label or write a sentence describing your favorite character.</p> <p><b>Modification:</b> Have someone read to you. Ask and answer questions about the book with an adult. (See attached question guide.)</p>	<p><b><u>Favorite Place</u></b> Draw a picture of your favorite place. Add labels to show what you would find there.</p> <p>Example: If you draw the beach, try to write words like sand, sun, ocean.</p>	<p><b><u>Animals</u></b> Draw an animal and label words to name body parts.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Write sentences to tell about the animal.</p> <p><b>Modification:</b> Dictate sentences to an adult and have him/her write it down.</p>	<p><b><u>Physical Education</u></b> <a href="#">Be Fit Bingo!</a></p> <p>Try to earn a BINGO! The same page is also in your packet.</p> <p><b>Technology</b> (choose one) Try a digital <a href="#">Breakout Edu</a>. Try an unplugged (without technology) <a href="#">coding activity</a>. Do the <a href="#">Hour of Code</a> at home!</p>
<p><b><u>Search and Sort</u></b> Find 10 items in your house and group them 2 different ways.</p> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p><b><u>Math Practice Pages</u></b> Complete paper and pencil activities provided in our practice packet.</p>	<p><b><u>Rhyming</u></b> Name something in your house and think of a rhyme Example: chair- bear, door- store</p> <p>.OR</p> <p><b><u>Reading Practice Pages</u></b> Complete paper and pencil activities provided in our practice packet.</p>	<p><b><u>All About Me</u></b> Draw or make a picture of yourself. Use stickers, crayons, paint or other supplies you have. Write words or sentences to tell about yourself.</p> <p><b>Modification:</b> Dictate sentences to an adult and have him/her write it down.</p>	<p><b><u>Today's Weather</u></b> Draw a picture of the weather today.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Write words or sentences to describe the weather.</p> <p><b>Modification:</b> Dictate sentences to an adult and have him/her write it down.</p>	<p><b><u>Art</u></b> <b>Design</b> Build a city using blocks/Legos.</p> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p><b><u>Picture Creation</u></b> Draw or make a picture and write about it. Use stickers, crayons, paint or other supplies you have.</p>
<p><b><u>Comparing Numbers</u></b> Make 2 piles of Legos or other blocks. Count how many are in each pile. Tell which pile is less and which pile is more.</p>	<p><b><u>Syllables</u></b> Name a food and count the number of syllables (word parts) Example broccoli- 3 syllables</p>	<p><b><u>Sight Words</u></b> Use your list of sight words and practice writing each word 3 times.</p>	<p><b><u>Play a Game</u></b> Play a game like Candy Land, Chutes and Ladders, Mouse Trap, Hungry, Hungry Hippo, etc.</p>	<p><b><u>Music</u></b> <a href="#">Click on this link for a Music Tic-Tac-Toe</a></p> <p>Or find the same page in your kindergarten packet</p>
