The Medinah School District will be hosting The DuPage County Health Department for vision and hearing screening this spring. This service has been on hold for the past two years, and we are very happy to welcome them back! Please review the following information:

- The DuPage County Health Department staff require all students to wear a face mask while they are being screened for vision and hearing.
 - Please pack a face mask for your child this will help us greatly! Of course, we will have extra masks for any students who need one.
- Screenings take about five minutes.
- Students who obtained an eye exam by a physician this school year, and those who wear glasses, will not be screened for vision.
- If a student does not pass their screening, parents/ guardians will be notified so they may follow up with an eye or ear doctor.
- Students who are not able to understand the instructions or participate in screenings will be marked "unable to test" and may try again next year. (This is common for our preschool students)



POPPY DAY POSTER CONTEST 2022 Roselle American Legion Auxiliary Unit 1084



The red **poppy** is a nationally recognized symbol of sacrifice worn by Americans since World War I to honor those who served and died for our country in all wars. It reminds Americans of the sacrifices made by our veterans while protecting our freedoms.

We are hosting a poppy day poster with cash prizes for first, second and third place. A certificate of participation will be awarded to each participant. Judging will be done by committee, awarding \$25 in cash to the first, second, and third place winner. Afterwards, the winning posters will be submitted to our national office to be entered in the national poppy day poster contest. Winners of national competition will be posted on the national American legion website.

Posters must be submitted by May16. Judging will be on May 17; the winners announced the week of May 18.

Poppy Poster Requirements

- 1. Each poster shall have a fitting slogan not to exceed 10 words. Articles "a", "and," "an", "the" are not to be counted as words. The words "buddy" and "buy" cannot be used.
- 2. The words "American Legion Auxiliary" must be used in the design of the poster and will not be counted in the 10-word count.
- 3. Each poster must include a picture of the red Flanders Field poppy.
- 4. The department shall determine the closing date of the unit contest. The poster shall be on 11x14" poster board. (Drawing paper will not be accepted).
- 5. The United States flag may be used as long as there are no infractions of the flag code.
- 6. Posters will be judged using the following criteria:
 - 50% poster appeal (layout, message, originality)
 - 40% artistic ability (design and color)
 - 10% neatness
- 7. Media used shall be watercolors, crayons, powder or oil paint, handmade paper cutouts, ink or textures, acrylics, pencils and markers.
- 8. Written in ink on the back of the poster (not attached) shall be the class in which the entry is submitted, the name, address, age and grade of the contestant and the name of the department.
- 9. Submissions become property of the American Legion Auxiliary. Through submission of artwork, contestants and their legal guardians' grant non-exclusive reproduction and publication rights to the works submitted and agree to have their names and artwork published for commercial use without additional compensation or permission.
- 10. The poster shall be the work of only one individual.
- 11. The label "In Memoriam" from the veteran-made poppy may not be used.
